

Alice and Arnold Soderwall Community Scholarship

For Environmental Studies or Environmental Science Majors
at the University of Oregon

To acknowledge exceptional scholars who are active participants in improving their community, the Environmental Studies Program will award three scholarships of \$1,500 each. The funds will be dispersed in equal payments of \$500 across Fall, Winter, and Spring terms of 2018-19 to cover tuition expenses.

ELIGIBILITY

Undergraduates with a declared major in either Environmental Studies or Environmental Science who are in good standing are eligible and encouraged to apply.

CRITERIA

The scholarship committee will give preference to students who have demonstrated high academic achievement and service to the community, the campus and beyond.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applications must include:

1. A current resume.
2. A letter of application that provides (a) a brief statement, no more than two pages, describing how your involvement in activities has benefited the community; (b) the name and email address of one UO faculty member or member of a community organization who has agreed to serve as a reference; and (c) your UO ID#. Note that the committee will check academic transcripts and take these into consideration, although there is no minimum GPA requirement.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 4:30 PM, MAY 7, 2018.

Completed applications should be e-mailed as a single pdf file to the Environmental Studies Program Manager, Monica Guy (monica@uoregon.edu). Please put "Soderwall Community Scholarship" in the subject line of the e-mail. The committee will review only complete and timely applications. Final decisions will be made by the committee and announced by the end of Spring term, 2018.
